TASK

- You are going to make a paper slide video to warn this generation that they need to work hard to reduce climate change and global warming to prevent the suffering of future generations.
- **Write** your script and decide what you are going to say
- Try to use present **perfect simple** and **present perfect continuous** e.g. “ we have been destroying the planet for too long” “ this has led to oceans being poisoned”
- You can also use 1st conditional e.g “ if we don’t do something now, we will all suffer in the future.
- **Draw** and **design** the images for your paper slide.
- When you are ready to film decide who is going to take each role. You need a **narrator**, **cameraperson** and **1 or 2 people to do the “paper-sliding”**.
- **Film** your paper slide video on your phone or recording device.
- **Present** your film to the rest of the class.

SUCCESS CRITERIA

- Your paper slide video should have a **title** to engage the audience
- You should use **present perfect simple** and **present perfect continuous** to talk about the situation and what has been happening to the environment.
- You can use 1st conditional to warn this generation that their actions now will have consequences in the future.
- Everyone should **contribute** and **share** their ideas.
- Your video should give a **strong message** to this generation
- You should work together to **produce** and **present** your paper slide
